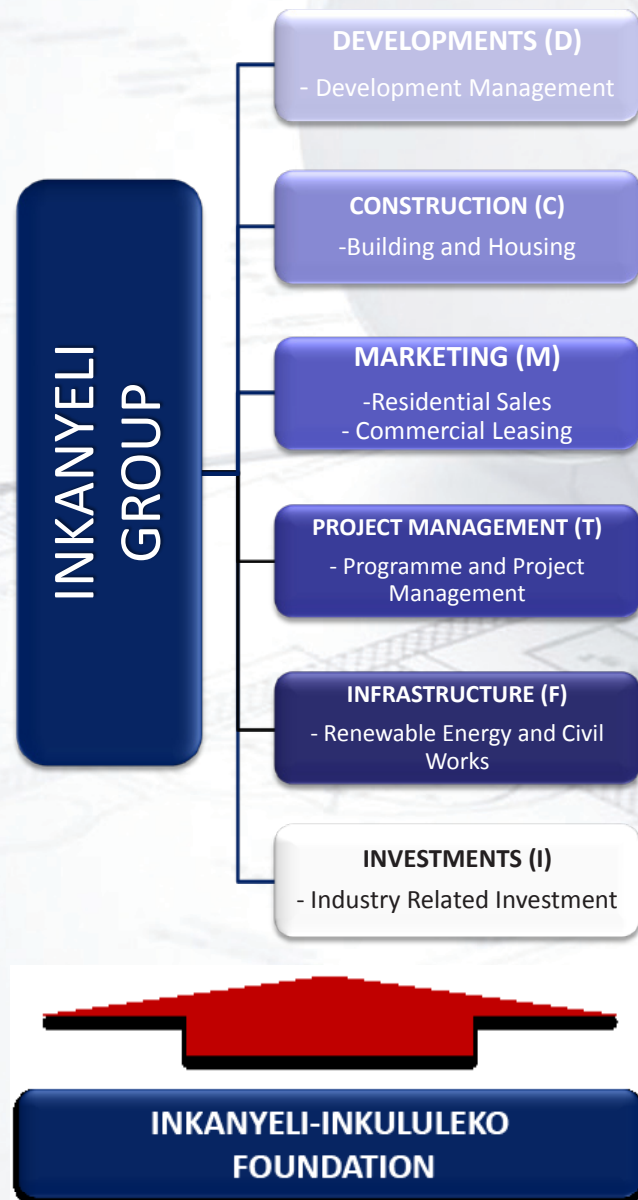

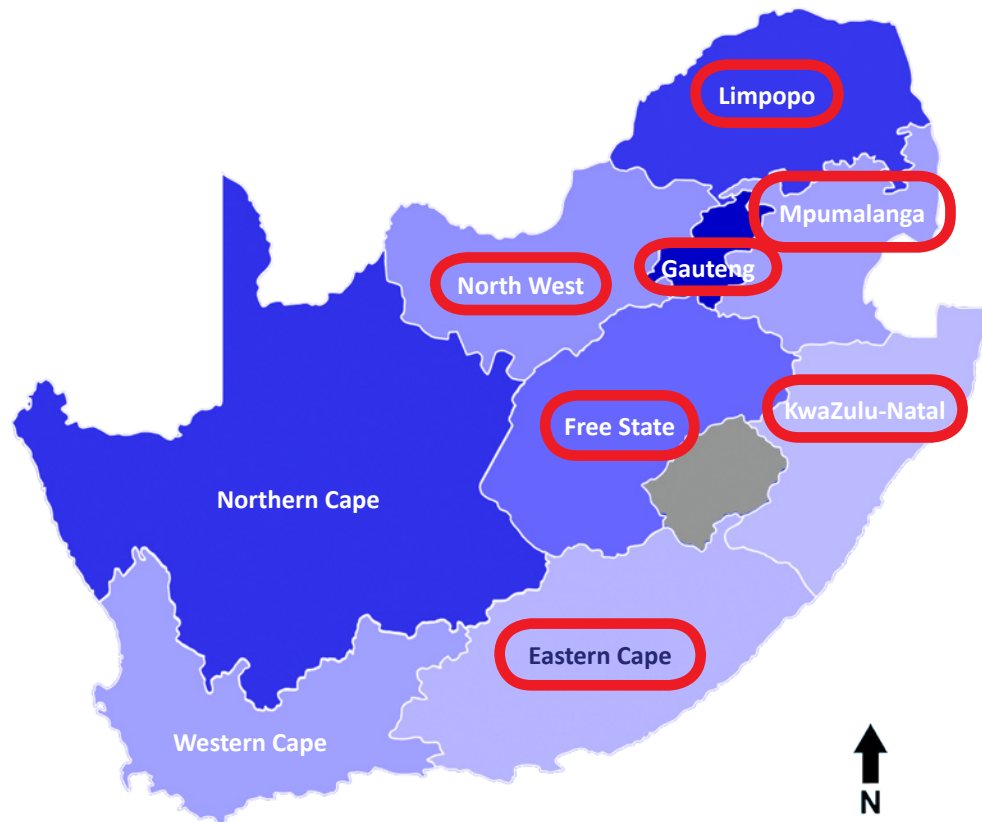

GEOGRAPHIC FOOTPRINT

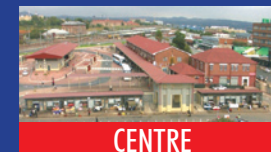

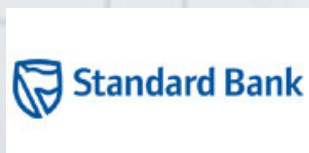

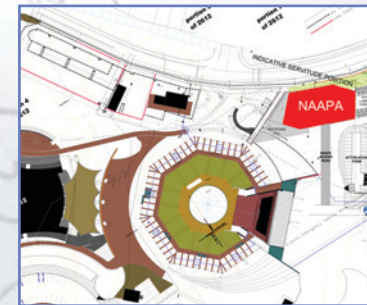
